

# Open Access and FOOD's most used Journals

This list aims to help give you a quick overview of the Open Access rules of the most used Journals at FOOD. You should always check the specific journal websites for more in-depth clarification of their restrictions associated with Open Access.

## How are the journals on this list chosen?

The journals on this list are chosen, because they are where employees at FOOD published the most articles in the years 2019-2020.

## What is Gold OA?

Gold OA is when an APC is paid to the journal, in order to make the article Open Access at the time of publishing. Golden OA Journals are journals that only offer this way of publishing, and not the more traditional subscription route for authors.

## What is Green OA?

Also called the self-archiving route, Green OA is when the author archives another version of their article (typically the Accepted Manuscript) in a repository in order to make the article Open Access.

## What is a Hybrid Journal?

A Hybrid Journal is a subscription journal that offer authors the chance to make their article Open Access, most commonly for an APC.

## What is a Transformative Journal?

A transformative journal is a hybrid journal that is transforming itself into a fully Golden Open Access journal. This will typically be done by increasing the amount of Open Access articles in the journal slowly over a period of time.

## What is the Elsevier agreement?

The national licensing consortium has entered an agreement with the publisher Elsevier that stretches between 2021-2024. In the agreement, APC fees for Open Access publishing is waived for a large amount of Elsevier's journals. Journals in the list that fall under the Elsevier agreement are colored in yellow.

## What is an APC?

The Article Processing Charge is a term use to describe the price you pay to journals for them to make your article Open Access.

## What is an Accepted Manuscript?

An Accepted Manuscript is also called the post-print, and is your paper after it has been accepted for publication and undergone peer review, but has not been given any page layout or typography from the publisher. Some journals have their own definition of what a post-print is, so always check with your publisher what their definition is.
